**RE: Health and Wellbeing Pupil Survey**

Dear Parents and Carers,

This letter is to inform you that Wigginton Primary School is working with the Public Health Team at City of York Council to deliver a health and wellbeing survey. The purpose of this survey is to expand our understanding of the health and wellbeing of children and young people growing up in York today. This will inform decisions about support and services for children and young people's health in the City.

Your child's year group has been selected to take part. Your child will complete this survey during the autumn term as part of the school day. It is an online survey and is designed and created by a company called InsightNow. A member of school staff will be on hand to answer any questions that your child might have.

The questions will cover a broad range of topics: dental health, physical activity, food and nutrition, mental wellbeing, happiness and worries, body image, bullying, volunteering, and sleep. We will also ask some demographic questions such as gender and ethnicity.

The survey will not ask for your child's name and we will only try to identify your child from their answers if we need to keep them safe because of a safeguarding concern.
