Thank you for enquiring about guitar lessons at Wigginton Primary School. This letter will hopefully give you the information you need regarding how lessons will run with some information about my musical background and teaching ethics.

About Me

I began learning the classical guitar at age 8 and continued to have lessons through school and university. My interest in guitar developed into playing acoustic and electric guitar. I took GCSE music at Manor C of E School, then gained an advanced Diploma in Popular music and received a BMus in Music from The University of Sheffield. I have been teaching and performing professionally in Yorkshire for over 20 years and use this knowledge and experience to enrich my guitar lessons.

Teaching Ethics

I believe that learning a musical instrument should be an enjoyable experience, so I make sure that lessons are fun and entertaining, while still having a structure towards progression and development. I choose appropriate books and materials for each pupil, so they have a guided advancement in their guitar playing. I can prepare pupils for music grades, but some prefer to learn for fun, which is totally fine.

Lessons

Lessons are either one-to-one or in small groups – both are 30 minutes long. One-to-one lessons gives your child a chance to have individual lesson time tailored towards their learning. Group lessons improve skills of playing with other people. Both group lessons and one-to-one lessons complement each other very well.

Lessons are charged at the start of each half term and paid via bank transfer to me (rather than the school).
