Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 5/6 Trip to the Ripon Museums for a Crime & Punishment Activity Day

On **Wednesday 4th February**, Year 5 and 6 will be going to the Ripon Museums for a Crime & Punishment Activity Day as part of our topic work. As part of the day, pupils will have the chance to visit two of the museums: the Courthouse and Prison & Police Museums.

TIMES: Coaches will be leaving school at 9.05 am on the morning of the trip. We will be returning to school at approximately 3.20pm.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Children will need to bring a few items on the day: a packed lunch (with a drink), a small rucksack to carry their lunch in and a coat in case of wet weather - we will be walking between the two museum locations. Full school uniform is required.

COST: We are asking for a contribution of **£20.00 per child** to cover some of the costs for transport and workshops/museum. *The PTA has funded a significant portion of the cost of this trip and it is greatly appreciated.*

There is no obligation to contribute and no pupil will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit will need to be CANCELLED if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions.

If your child is entitled to free school meals, we can provide a packed lunch on the day of the trip. The packed lunch will consist of a ham OR cheese sandwich; a piece of fruit; a biscuit or bun & water. Alternatively, you can provide your child with a packed lunch. Please indicate your choice on the consent form.

We need a limited number of adult helpers to accompany us. If you are able to help us on our visit, please indicate this on the e-consent form. Your child's teacher will confirm if your help is needed as soon as possible.
