Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are just finalising our arrangements for the forthcoming trip. I hope the children are getting excited because they are going to have a fantastic time! Please find attached some information & forms for our trip to Kingswood. Copies are also available on the school website:

- **Parental Consent Form.** Please fully complete and sign the attached **Parental Consent Form** & return it to the school office **by Thursday 16th July 2026**. Please include a summary of any medicine or inhalers your child may need to have with them on the trip. Without this form your child will not be able to attend the residential.
- If your child needs to take **ANY medicines (including inhalers & travel sickness medicine)** with them on the trip you will be required to complete a school 'Parental Consent Form for administering medicines' on the morning they leave. Forms are also available on the school website ([Useful Forms](#)) for you to print in advance or a hard copy is available from the school office. Once the form is completed this must be given, together with the medicine/ inhaler, to the office staff who will be available on the morning of departure. All medicines will be securely stored by staff, with the exception of any children who carry their own inhalers. ALL medicines must be clearly labelled and in their original packaging.
- **A suggested packing list** & items NOT to bring to Dearne Valley;
There will be no calls home by the children and **mobile phones are not permitted on the visit**. **Tracking devices are NOT permitted as they pose a safeguarding risk to all children present**. We would also request that children do not bring any sweets or chocolate.

- **EMERGENCY PROCEDURE**

- **Please note** *the site is a nut free site, no nuts or nut products should be taken; NO cameras should be taken on the trip, including disposables; and if your child is sick less than 48 hours before the start of the trip they will not be able to attend.*
