The Mini Run is a 1.5km route around the York Racecourse and is open to everyone aged between 3-8. They must run with a parent or guardian. The event starts at 12pm.

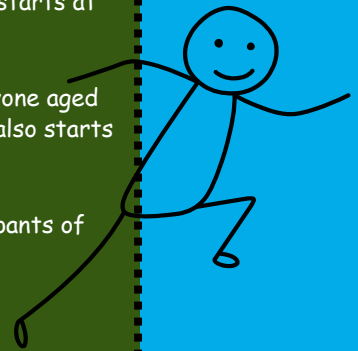

For the first time in 2026, the Junior Run is chip timed and all participants of both runs receive a medal/trophy and a goody bag!

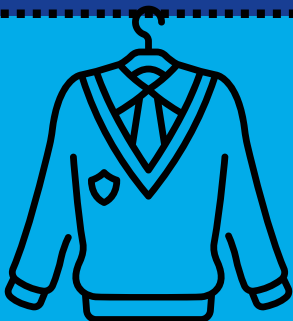
The race is great fun and a brilliant show of community spirit.

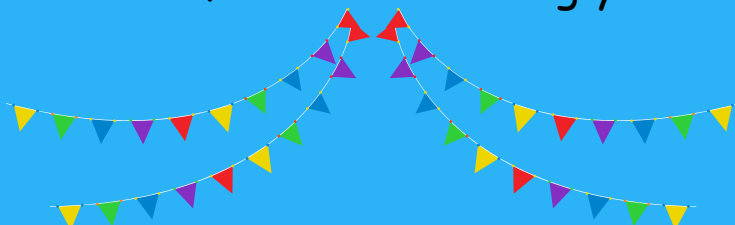
