



# Wigginton Primary School



As the warm sunshine arrives, please remember:

- all children should have a named sunhat in school which they will be encouraged to wear when playing outside. Wide brimmed hats or those which cover the neck are ideal;
- to apply a long lasting sunscreen before school in sunny weather, as staff are not permitted to apply this to children;
- your child's class water bottle should not contain juice - only water is allowed in class.

The water fountains in each key stage area in school are available for pupils to refill their water bottles if required during the school day. As the weather improves, it is important that children are drinking plenty of water during the day.

For the rest of this week, children are able to wear PE kit instead of uniform. This should be a white t-shirt with blue or black shorts. Year 5 pupils can also wear this on Wednesday when they visit The Joseph Rowntree School. Reception children are already able to wear non-uniform for their visit to Stockeld Park on Thursday.

On Wednesday, we will have a special Reception and Year 1/2 slip and slide during lunchtime! This will then be repeated for Key Stage 2 on Thursday! Children will need a full change of clothes and a small towel in a plastic bag!

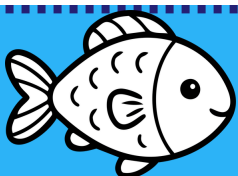

For the first time in 2026, the Junior Run is chip timed and all participants of both runs receive a medal/trophy and a goody bag!

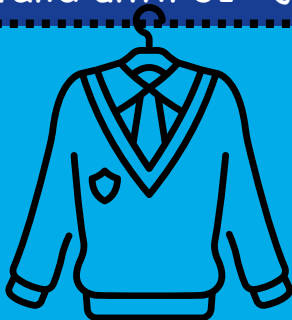
The race is great fun and a brilliant show of community spirit.

## Parent/Carer Workshop

Our next parent/carers workshop will be on the 29th June at 9am. We are very lucky to have two external professionals attending the workshop who are from Wildflower neuro and SEND Central:

### Wildflower Neuro:

This is a new business supporting parents/carers with early intervention support. Beth offers neurodevelopmental screening and strategies that may help to support with challenging behaviours, emotion based school avoidance, aggression, meltdowns and demand avoidance, to name a few. She is able to support parents/carers to make decisions around possible ADHD/ASD referrals, looking at both NHS and private routes, as well as providing strategies that might support whilst waiting during the assessment period. This support can be home and/or school based.

### SEND Central

Claire from SEND Central, which is based in Clifton, will also be attending and will be able to provide families with information relating to what they can offer within the local area. SEND Central have a wide range of workshops/family sessions available, many of which are free to attend and cover many aspects of SEND, e.g. neurodiversity, anxiety and supporting transitions.

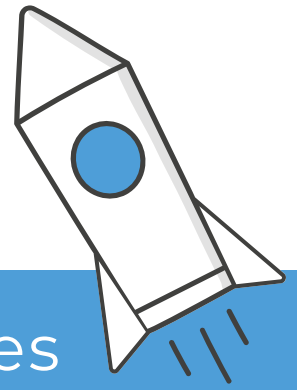
