Lunchtimes Update

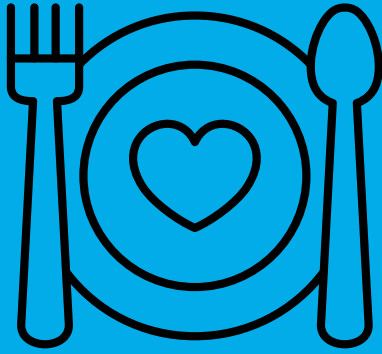

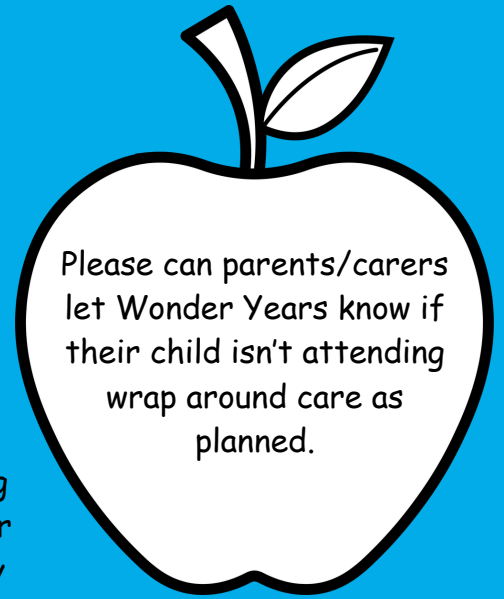
Ana was very impressed with everything she saw when she came, both during lunchtime itself and during the meeting afterwards with the OPAL Working Party. She spoke to lots of children and staff and looked at our plans for further developing OPAL.

We are incredibly proud to have now achieved the **Platinum Standard** for OPAL play, the highest accolade available, putting us in the top 2% of all schools nationally with the quality of our play provision.

This is in recognition of the incredible variety of resources the children have access to at lunchtimes as well as all the routines and systems in place - such as OPAL assemblies, parent play sessions, staff meetings, play team meetings - and our plans to keep adding to our provision. Here's to lots more fun and exciting play at lunchtimes!

Please can parents/carers let Wonder Years know if their child isn't attending wrap around care as planned.



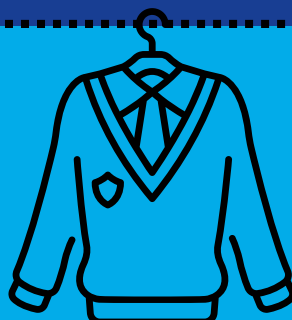
Missing School Books!

During the workshop, we'll explore:

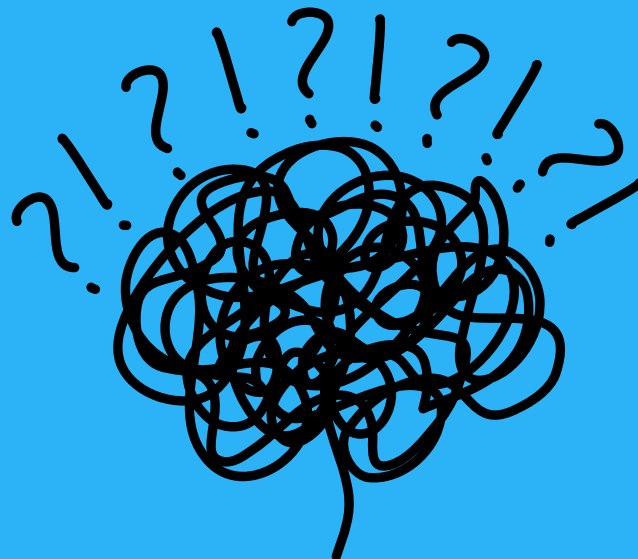
